Recommended: Graphing Calculator: TI-84 Plus, TI-84 Plus CE, TI-83 Plus (simplest), or TI-Nspire CX (most advanced); ask teacher which calculator would be appropriate for individual needs in high school as well as future college plans to choose a calculator
Pre-Calculus/Advanced Math (11th Grade)
1 - 1.5 inch three ring binder w/ dividers
300 Sheets of graph paper -- three hole punched
Required: Graphing Calculator: TI-84 Plus, TI-84 Plus CE, TI-83 Plus (simplest), or TI-Nspire CX (most advanced); ask teacher which calculator would be appropriate for individual needs in high school as well as future college plans to choose a calculator
